THE COMMUNITY COUNCIL'S CRITERIA FOR CONSIDERING APPLICATIONS, FROM VOLUNTARY AND CHARITABLE BODIES, FOR ASSISTANCE WITH FUNDING.

- 1. All Applications shall be considered by the Llay Community Council.
- 2. The Council must receive all applications at least 7 days prior to the meeting at which the appeal will be heard. **Late applications will not be considered.**
- 3. The Community Council will normally consider the applications once a month. Please note, there is normally no meeting held in August.
- 4. Funds given to any organisation must be used to benefit the residents of the geographical area of Llay.
- 5. The onus is on the Organisation to submit its application to the Community Council. The Council will not distribute application forms automatically.
- 6. Organisations should be aware that any award if made and the amount thereof is at the discretion of the Community Council. <u>Grants are not ongoing year on year</u>. The applicant shall indicate other funding applied for/granted from other organisations including other Local Councils and give evidence of fund raising activities already undertaken.
- 7. The Community Council requires all applicants for financial assistance to provide an audited statement of their financial affairs.
- 8. Any organisation / applicant receiving a grant of £500 or more in any one financial year, will required to provide a written report of how the money has been used. The report must be provided within 6 months of the end of the financial year in which the grant was made and must identify the means of spending. If a report is not provided within the 6 month period, all future applications will be placed in jeopardy.
- 9. Applications to be submitted to the Clerk at the above address.
- 10. The Clerk will acknowledge all applications.
- 11. After ratification by the Community Council, the Clerk will inform all applicants whether or not their application has been successful.
